

What is an anonymized manuscript?

Please remove any identifying information, such as authors' names or affiliations, from your manuscript before submission and give all information about authors at title page section. Please upload title page section separately from the manuscript.

In addition to following the instructions above, other steps need to be taken to ensure the manuscript is correctly prepared for double-blind peer review. The key points to consider are:

- Please don't use authors name to refer to your previously published article. For example, write "Black and Hart (2015) have demonstrated" rather than "we/the authors have previously demonstrated (Black & Hart, 2015)".
- Also, make sure that any figures and tables do not contain any reference to author affiliations.
- Use the title page, which is not sent to reviewers, to detail acknowledgements or any references to funding sources to declare any potential conflicts of interest to the editor.
- Choose uploaded file names anonymized.
- Finally, ensure that you do not inadvertently upload identifying information to the files except title page, cover letter and LaTeX source files.
